Agency Information: The Statewide Referral Network for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children, SRNDHH, is a unique network created to provide quality services for families of deaf and hard of hearing children. We provide comprehensive information and resources regarding the unique communication opportunities available to families who have deaf and hard of hearing children, and coordinate services on a statewide level resulting in greater capacity to serve this unique population. Families may be enrolled with a local Provider Network as well as referred to the SRNDHH and receive services from both networks as determined by the IFSP. Our seamless system of supports and services to families expands availability of various language development opportunities and specialists, provides an interdisciplinary approach by coordinating efforts of specialty providers in conjunction with additional therapies when indicated, helps support the family once they have chosen communication opportunities, and finds resources that match both current and future needs of the child.
